


Collecting food waste for pigs in Maine?

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

Feeding pigs food scraps that contain meat, fish or food contaminated with these products can lead to pig illness or death.

         	<h1>YES</h1>		<p>It's ok to feed pigs uncontaminated fruits, vegetables, bread, grains, dairy, eggs, and vegetable oils.</p>		         	<h1>NO</h1>	<p>Do not feed pigs meat or fish, or their bones, oils, or juices, or ANY food that has touched these substances.</p>

Farmers feeding food scraps to pigs that do not follow the guideline above **MUST** be licensed by both the USDA and Maine Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry
