Dear Jodi,

The Town of Greenville has received your letter regarding the Big Moose Redevelopment in Big Moose Township. Currently the Town of Greenville is contracted with Piscataquis County to provide Solid Waste Removal for that area.

In regards to your request of the acceptance of approximately 7,770 cubic yards of construction and demolition debris; The Town of Greenville currently is not capable of accepting/ receiving that amount demolition debris due to the Transfer Station container capacity. We do not have enough containers or the availability to transport it to its final destination in Bangor in a timely manner. We are capable of handling small quantities, however not all at once.

In regards to the Municipal Solid Waste (msw); the Greenville Transfer Station is capable and willing to accept additional waste from the proposed Big Moose Redevelopment area in the future.

I encourage a meeting with the Piscataquis County Manager and myself to discuss the impact to the county's budget as well as the town's budget; as Greenville receives payment from the county for the use of the Transfer Station.
