LURC staff has completed the review of the petition submitted by Maine Mountain Power, LLC (MMP) to determine if it is complete for processing. MMP made revisions to the petition, initially submitted on December 19, 2005, in response to staff comments, and submitted a revised petition on February 7, 2006. MMP's request to rezone their parcels on Redington Mountain and Black Nubble Mountain in Redington Township to a (D-PD) Planned Development Subdistrict, and the proposed Preliminary Development Plan for a 30 turbine wind farm and associated facilities, was accepted for processing on February 8, 2006.
