Maine Mountain Power, LLC (MMP) is pleased to submit this permit application for the proposed Redington wind farm.

This single permit application incorporates a request for a Land Use Regulation Commission (LURC) re-zoning, a LURC Application for Non-Residential Development (Supplement S-2), a LURC Application for Wetland Alterations (Supplement S-3) and an application for a permit from the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) under the Site Location of Development Law.

Since this application was drafted over a period of time, it refers extensively to Redington Mountain Windpower, LLC or "RMW." On November 7, 2005, Redington Mountain Windpower, LLC signed a lease with Maine Mountain Power, LLC. (Maine Mountain Power, LLC is a joint development LLC set up by Endless Energy Corporation and a subsidiary of Edison Mission Group.
