## **APPENDIX C**

This collection of photographs were taken between July, 1998 and August, 2004 to illustrate characteristic landscapes within 15 miles of the Black Nubble Wind Farm. The photographs were taken under a variety of atmospheric conditions during different times of the day and year to give a comprehensive view of the study area.
