Enclosed please find the following updated tables and drawings reflecting the minor changes resulting from the shift in location of Turbine 11 to the west and downslope of its previously proposed location.

- Table B.13-3 (land area affected by the Kibby Expansion Project);
- Table B.13-5 (cut and fill estimates);
- Table B.15-1 (summary of wetland impacts);
- Table B.15-2 (wetland impacts associated with crane path and turbine construction);
- Project Footprint Maps (four pages); and,
- Revised project drawings included in B.13-1 (G-3, C-1, C-2, C-3, C-6 and C-8).

For ease of review, we have provided redlined and clean versions of each of Tables B.13-3, B.13-5, B.15-1 and B.15-2. Also, we have provided two extra sets of the revised project drawings (full size) for distribution to LURC review staff. We are also sending the complete package, including the oversized drawings, to Nancy O'Toole and Jenn Burns Gray, by overnight mail. The oversized drawings are not included electronically.

The change in turbine location was made in response to project review comments from MNAP and IF&W and to reduce impacts to the subalpine community. TransCanada identified the change and provided a revised map of the project layout in its Response to Agency Comments filed with LURC and copied to the parties on April 9, 2010. TransCanada also discussed the change and included a map depicting the change in its Pre-Filed Testimony filed in April 21, 2010.

Also attached is the Breeding Bird Survey Report for the Sisk Mountain Wind Power Project prepared by Biodiversity Research Institute. This report was specifically requested by Maine Audubon in their pre-filed testimony.
