Syphilis Symptoms

- Painless sore that may appear around the mouth, genitals, or anal area.
- A rash that can often appear anywhere on the body, and oftentimes on the palms of the hands and bottoms of the feet.
- These symptoms may appear and disappear even without treatment.
- Syphilis is treatable, but requires timely medical attention.

Get Tested Today

- If you are experiencing signs or symptoms.
- If you are getting tested for other STIs.
- Get tested 2-4 a year if you
 - are sexually active
 - have sex without a condom
 - have more than one sex partner
 - are a man having sex with other men
- If you are pregnant or plan to get pregnant in the future.
