
1994 MAINE BIRTHS

Maine Residents: 1985 - 1994 (preliminary data)

- The preliminary count of births for 1994 indicates that in that year there were 14.397 live births to Maine residents. That represents the lowest count of live births to Maine women since 1901 when there were 14,021 births. The 1994 count continues a 5 year downward trend in the number of annual live births to resident women.
- The number of out-of-wedlock births in Maine has increased from 3,006 births in 1985 to 4,059 in 1994. As a percentage of live births, out-of-wedlock births have increased - from 18% in 1985 to 28% in 1994.



- In 1985, 58% of the live births to women younger than 20 years old were out-of-wedlock births; this proportion increased steadily over the decade. By 1994, this percentage had grown to 81%.
- The number of out-of-wedlock births to adolescent women has remained relatively stable over the decade fluctuating between 1.100 and 1,300 annually; however, of all out-of-wedlock births, the percent of out-of-wedlock births to adolescent women has decreased from 38% to 30%. Similarly, the number and the percent of all live births to women under 20 has also decreased - from 12% of all births to 10% (from 2,000 to 1,500).
- The pregnancy rate for Maine women 15 44 years old has decreased during the past decade from 78 per 1,000 women to 61. For women 15 - 19 years old, it has decreased from 69 per 1,000 women to 51.

Notes: The pregnancy rate is the number of reported live births, induced abortions, and fetal deaths per 1,000 female population in the age group under discussion, i.e., 15 - 44 years old or 15 - 19 years old.

Adolescent women are defined as women under the age of 20 years old.
