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
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- **Health Care Resources**
- Physicians: 193 physicians (MD and DO) indicated that they were practicing in York county; 50% of these physicians (96) reported practicing in a primary care* specialty; the national figure was 47%.

YORK COUNTY: 1992

- Registered Nurses: There were 669 registered nurses practicing their profession in York county resulting in a nurse to physician ratio of 3.5 nurses for every doctor; this compares to the national ratio of 3 nurses per doctor.
- Dentists: 64 dentists reported working in York county. The resulting ratio of .4 dentists for every 1,000 residents was significantly less than the national ratio of .6/1,000. The state ratio was .4 dentists for every 1,000 residents.
- Hospitals: There were 3 hospitals in York county with a total of 284 general use hospital beds. This yielded a county ratio of 1.7 beds per 1,000 residents, significantly less than the nationwide ratio of 4.0/1,000. Statewide this ratio was 3.5 per 1,000.

Nursing Homes: There were 15 long term care facilities with 1,014 nursing home beds in 1992; this represented a county ratio of 47 nursing home beds per 1,000 elderly population; nationwide this ratio was 48 beds per 1,000 elderly.
